The Time to Talk About Death Is Now

Transitions Care believes that every human deserves individualized care, personalized to reflect their own needs, values, and end of life wishes. "A study from the Kaiser Family Foundation and The Economist found that nearly 80 percent of people have thought about their wishes at the end of life, but fewer than 20 percent actually discussed those wishes with

their healthcare provider." Aditi Mallick, MD, Assistant Clinical Professor of Medicine at the George Washington University School of Medicine and Health Sciences, shares this story with the <u>End Well</u> team, highlighting this very important topic of discussion.



"When it was time for our Mother to enter end of life care, the Doctors and other caregivers gave us names of companies that manage the process for patients like my mother. "Research informs us that teens tend to suppress or deny their emotions more than children."
